wards for my son Arundell absolutely.

I have given the contents of my chambers to my son Arundell some time
ago and my wife owns a great many part of the furniture at 1 Buckingham Place
Mansions and Toppin called Frederick Bay. Her word is the conclusive as to this.

I would desire my wife and my son to keep the money clerk S. G. Archer
and to remember him when they make their will after my death.

I desire a private funeral at Wanden Church and if practicable I would
wish two memorial windows over the resting place of my little children.
