I have received your letter this morning - also I have received Twelve pounds from the Amherst Bank for which I feel greatly obliged to you - You have done every thing right and I have received them safe - I had put the letter in the post which yesterday before I received your letter today - and I thought that I had better write to you for afraid of you being uneasy thinking that I did not receive them, I shall be sure if live and well to come and see you the beginning of May next when I return from the College. and if I can possibly meet with a place I shall stop there for next summer, and attend the Royal infirmary there until I have

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completed my studies— I imagine also that Manchester
would be a very good place to set up in business
as I am not aware of any Doctor there being
a Welchman— and I believe there are about
thirty thousand Welch inhabitants in it, I think
going to the college by way of Gurych, and to
take Charles home at the same time, I shall write
to you again as soon as I shall arrive at
Edinburgh— Catherine Jones Glycoed is courting
very warmly with Edward Owen of Tyn y Llwyn— and
Mary desired me to tell you that Evan ffrw ffrw is
paying his addresses to her— and that he is now
a Captain of a large Vessel— also Margaret
has been courting in a late wedding, with Isaac Jones
of Belin Bach— an Attorney at Law— I had great
pains to prevent them from burning this letter

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after they receive what I have said about
 them - All desire to be kindly remembered to you
 and all your friends and relations - wishing
 you much happiness and health
