WIND TABLE

These marks are the result of many years of observation and are intended to be used as a guide only. They will by simple inspection show the character of the weather and will most probably follow the entrance of the wind from the quarter, and that so near the truth as to be almost certain.

1. The Moon's Change, First Quarter, Full, and Last Quarter, being during six of the afternoon hours, i. e. from four to ten, is followed by fair weather; but this is mostly dependent on the Moon being near to MIDNIGHT, or the weather being the more foul or wet the weather is the more so.
