Dear Dr. Jones,

With regard to your query concerning Thomas H. Price M.R.C.S.
(Eng.) L.K.Q.C.P., I have found the following information :

He is first mentioned in the Medical Directory for 1870, and his address is given as Bangor, Carnarvonshire. This may be the parental home in Wales that you mention in your letter.

In the Directory of 1871 his address is at 1, Price-Str., Birkenhead. Appended to this entry is "(Ledw. Sch. and Mercer's Hosp. Dubl.)". Therefore he must have attended the Ledwich School of Anatomy, Medicine and Surgery in Dublin. Certificates awarded by this school were recognised by the R.C.S.(Eng.) and the K.Q.C.P.I.

In 1872 he is listed as Assistant Resident House Surgeon to the East Dispensary, Liverpool. In 1873 he is Assistant Surgeon to the Workhouse Hospital Manchester. In 1874 he has an address at 4, James-Str., Smithfield, Manchester. He is also Medical Officer Cathedral District Manchester Union. In 1876 he is listed as being a member of the British Medical Association.

The last reference to him is in the Directory of 1895, where he is stated to be Medical Officer 2nd District and Pub. Vacc. 1st & 2nd District Manchester Union. His address is at 39, Gt. Ancoats-Str., Manchester.

When Thomas Price was admitted as Licentiate of the K.Q.C.P.I. on July 14th, 1869, he stated as his place of residence Bangor, North Wales.

I hope this information will be of some value to you.
